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The Essential Job Search Manual

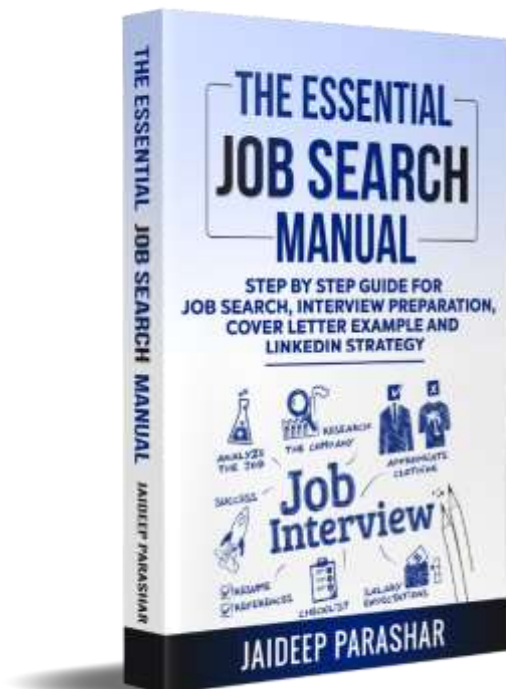
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## Instructions

1. Although networking plays a bigger role in job search yet candidate never plan their networking properly. Networking is not about increasing the number of follower but have meaningful connections from your domain and industry.
2. Before reaching out to your network, prepare a through SWOT analysis of your education, experience. When you approach, your network shares your cover letter, resume and SWOT analysis. Keep your SWOT in a few bullet points only.
3. Make a list of all the people, whom you can approach, their profile and company name.
4. Never send only a resume in a simple message. If you have the email id then send a formal email with all the details.
5. After sending the email, wait for 48-72 hours before a follow up reminder.
6. Prepare the list diligently, it will help you.
